*The James & Bernaldyne. Hamilton Legacy Scholarship* is established through Revive Christian Center- New Harvest Ministries to honor the enduring impact, faith, and service of Bishop James E. Hamilton and Lady Bernaldyne Hamilton. This scholarship seeks to invest in the next generation of leaders who embody Christian character, a heart for ministry, and a commitment to excellence in both vocation and service.

Designed for graduating high school seniors, this scholarship supports students who plan to pursue vocational training (with an emphasis in HVAC) or a career pathway in Healthcare Administration. It reflects the Hamiltons’ legacy of practical empowerment—equipping individuals not only to succeed professionally, but to serve their communities with integrity and compassion.

### **Scholarship Purpose**

To provide financial assistance and spiritual encouragement to students who:

- Demonstrate a commitment to Christian ministry and service
- Are pursuing career pathways that meet critical community needs
- Exhibit strong character, leadership, and a spirit of excellence

### **Eligibility Requirements**

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Graduating High School Senior (current academic year)
- Accepted or enrolled in an accredited vocational/technical program (HVAC preferred), or college/university pursuing Healthcare Administration
- Active involvement in ministry (local church membership, auxiliary participation, outreach, etc.)
- Minimum GPA of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale)
- Demonstrated financial need (preferred but not required)
- Exhibits strong moral character, leadership potential, and commitment to service.



## **Application Requirements**

Applicants must submit the following:

1. Completed Scholarship Application Form
2. Official High School Transcript
3. Proof of Acceptance/Enrollment
4. One Letters of Recommendation (Pastor/Ministry Leader and Teacher/Counselor/Community Leader)
5. Personal Essay (500–750 words)
6. Resume or List of Activities

## **Selection Criteria**

Recipients will be selected based on:

- Commitment to faith and ministry
- Clarity of career goals
- Academic effort and persistence
- Leadership and community impact
- Quality of essay and recommendations

## **Award Details**

- Scholarship award amount: \$250.00
- Funds may be used for tuition, books, tools, or program-related expenses
- Recipient may be invited to attend a recognition ceremony on June 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026.
